
You are required to attach a separate cover letter and bio to your e-mail, along with an attachment containing only your poem submission. The cover letter and bio must not exceed 125 words each. You may attach the cover letter and bio as one document if desired. Again, please attach all materials as WORD DOCUMENTS.

If you are under 18 years of age, you must state your age, and the postal address and contact information for your parent or guardian so that in the event that your work is accepted for publication, Notable Works can follow up to obtain the required permission from them to publish your work.

Your cover letter MUST include the names of the poems you are submitting, along with your postal mailing address. These documents will be kept separate from your actual poems, so that all judging and evaluations from our panel can be done blindly. Please..... **DO NOT include any identifying information on your poems themselves.** This information will be in your cover letter/bio only, and attached as a separate document to your submission. Any identifying information on the poems themselves will disqualify the poem from consideration.
