All six winning poets will receive an award certificate signed by Tina Cane and have their poems published in the June 2025 issue of Notable Works’ monthly publication *Notable Notes*. Also, the six winning poets will be featured at a special event on May 3, 2025 in the auditorium at the William Hall Library in Cranston, RI. This event will also feature The Notable Works’ Ensemble performing songs from the new musical *Sell Division: Breaking the Chains of Perception*.

The top three winners will also be featured on the Cranston Public Library’s **On the Line** Program during National Poetry Month in April 2025.

The Submission Period will be January 1, 2025 - March 1, 2025

Reading Fee \$10 for first poem, \$5 for each additional poem (max. 4)
