Directions to the William Hall Library Auditorium in Cranston (1825 Broad St, just up from Pawtuxet Village)

From 95 going north. Take the route 10 exit and

take the right fork and then turn right onto Elmwood Avenue. You will come to a light and turn left onto Park Ave. go about a mile or so. You will go by a fire station on the left at a big intersection. Keep going straight. Follow Park Ave to where you must turn left or right. Turn to the left and the William Hall Library is set back from the street on your left about ¼ mile from where you turned left onto Broad St. The entrance to the library is just passed the library sign again on your left. Drive in and park in the back of the library and walk towards the library building from your car. The auditorium ramp is on your left in the back of the building and goes up the side of the library building and into the auditorium.

Going South on195 towards New York. Take the Cranston Street exit. Do not take the first exit off that exit. Take the next exit which is the Park Ave. exit off the Cranston Street exit further down. Stay to the left on route 10 and turn left onto Park Ave. That is a dead-end and you have to turn left or right. Turn left. Go straight for about a mile or so. You will go by a fire station on the left across the street at a big intersection. Keep going straight. Follow Park Ave to where you must turn left or right. Turn to the left and the William Hall Library is set back from the street on your left about ¼ mile from where you turned left onto Broad St. The entrance to the library is just passed the library sign again on your left. Drive in and park in the back of the library and walk towards the library building from your car. The auditorium ramp is on your left in the back of the building and goes up the side of the library building and into the auditorium.
