Notable Works' 2025/26 Art Initiative GUIDELINES

Submission Period: November 1, 2025 to February 1, 2026 (12 am EST)

THEME: "Bridging the Divide and Coming Together for a Common Goal" as it pertains to our natural environment. Submissions are Free and artists may submit from one to three original works.

Submission Requirements:

- Each artwork must be submitted in JPEG format with a minimum of 300 dpi
- All mediums will be accepted including photograph. Please keep in mind that all works accepted for publication will be printed in black and white.
- Please do not include any identifying information on your artwork(s). Only the title of the artwork must be included on the work of art itself.

How to set up your submission email:

- Send only one email. Include each artwork you are submitting as a separate attachment to the one email. Only JPEG images (min. 300 dpi) will be accepted. No PDFs.
- Do not include the artwork(s) in the body of the email.
- Attach a separate cover letter and a separate bio to the same one email and both must be a word document.
- The **cover letter** MUST include the title(s) of the artwork(s), along with your name, your email address, mailing address and telephone number.
- Your bio must not exceed 125 words. Artists under the age of 18 are required to state their age and parent or guardian's name, email and postal addresses and telephone number. If their work is accepted for publication, Notable Works will obtain the required permission from parent or guardian.
- In order for the judging to be blind both the cover letter and your bio will be kept separate from your artwork(s). Any identifying information on the artworks themselves will disqualify the artwork(s) from consideration.
